

ANALYSIS.

1. Short title.

AN ACT to provide for the Reinstatement 1917. of certain Persons as Purchasers of certain — Crown Lands, and for other purposes. [8 February, 1917.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Reinstatement of Crown Lands Short title. Purchasers' Act, 1917."

Crown Lands Purchasers' Reinstatement.

A.D. 1917.

Certain persons whose lands have peen forfeited may be reinstated as purchasers. Schedule (1).

Certain persons named in Schedule (2) to be permitted to complete their purchases.

Power to exchange certain land in the Parish of Douglas with Francis Cooper, the elder. Schedules (3) and (4).

Commissioner may sell certain land to the Trustees of the property of the Church of England, in Tasmania. Schedules (5) and (6).

Commissioner may sell certain land to Robert Coplestone. Schedule (7).

2 The Commissioner of Crown Lands may, with the consent of the Governor, reinstate the persons named in Schedule (1) hereto as purchasers of the several lots or areas of land set opposite to their names. under the provisions of the Acts regulating the sale or disposition of Crown lands under which the purchases of such lots or areas were respectively made; and thereupon such persons shall be liable to pay all instalments upon such lands at the date of forfeiture, and all instalments thereafter due thereon, together with the amount of fines and charges for the cost of advertising, as provided in Section Ninety-2 Geo. V. No. 64. six of "The Crown Lands Act, 1911," together with interest at the rate of Five Pounds per centum per annum from the date when such instalments became due.

> **3** Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any repealed or existing Act regulating the sale or disposition of lands of the Crown, it shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands to permit the persons named in Schedule (2) hereto to complete the purchase of the several areas of land set opposite to their names; and upon payment of the balance of purchase-money into the Treasury, together with a grant fee of Fifteen Shillings, the Governor is hereby authorised, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty the King, to convey and alienate the said lands to the said persons respectively, in fee simple, or for any less estate or interest.

> **4** Upon *Francis Cooper*, the elder, surrendering to His Majesty the King all his right, title, and interest in and to the land described in Schedule (3) hereto it shall be lawful for the Governor, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty the King, to convey and alienate the land described in Schedule (4) hereto to the said Francis Cooper, the elder, in fee simple, or for any less estate or interest.

> 5 It shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands to sell by private contract to the Trustees of the property of the Church of England in Tasmania the Crown land described in Schedules (5) and (6) hereto for the sum of Thirty-five Pounds; and upon payment of such sum of money into the Treasury, together with grant fees amounting to Thirty Shillings. the Governor is hereby authorised, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty the King, to convey and alienate the said land to the said trustees, in fee simple, or for any less estate or interest.

> 6 It shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown lands to sell by private contract to Robert Coplestone the lot of Crown land described in Schedule (7) hereto for the sum of Three Pounds; and upon payment of such sum of money into the Treasury, together with a grant fee of Fifteen Shillings, the Governor is hereby authorise , in the name and on behalf of His Majesty the King, to convey and alienate the said land to the said *Robert Coplestone*, in fee simple, or for any less estate or interest.

Crown Lands Purchasers' Reinstatement.

7 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in "The Crown Lands Act, 1911," it shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands, at the expiration of the term of the existing lease thereof, to lease Hope Island, situate at Port Esperance, by private contract, to James and Robert Sawers for such period not exceeding Fourteen years, at such annual rental not being less than Forty Pounds, and upon such terms and subject to such conditions generally as the Governor may approve.

8 Upon Davies Brothers Limited executing a certain agreement made or about to be made between the Commonwealth of the first part, His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania of the second part, and Davies Brothers Limited of the third part, and upon payment by Davies Brothers Limited into the Treasury of the sum of One hundred Pounds together with a grant fee of Fifteen Shillings, the Governor is hereby authorised, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty the King, to convey and alienate the land described in Schedule (8) hereto to Davies Brothers Limited in fee simple.

Upon the Governor so conveying such land the Act 1 Edwardi VII. No. 25, and Section Seventeen of the Act 8 Edwardi VII. No. 42, shall be deemed to be repealed.
