

********************************* AN ACT to provide for the Reinstatement of 1921. certain Persons as Purchasers of certain

Crown Lands, and for other purposes. [14 February, 1922.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Reinstatement of Crown Lands Short title. Purchasers' Act, 1921."
- 2 The Commissioner of Crown Lands may, with the consent of the Certain persons Governor, reinstate the persons named in Schedule (1) hereto as purchasers of the several lots or areas of land set opposite to their names, may be reinstated under the provisions of the Acts regulating the sale or disposition of as purchasers.

Crown lands under which the purchases of such lots or areas were respectively made; and thereupon such persons shall be liable to pay all instalments due upon such lands at the date of forfeiture, and all instalments thereafter due thereon, together with the amount of fines and charges for the cost of advertising, as provided in Section Ninetysix of "The Crown Lands Act, 1911," together with interest at the rate of Five Pounds per centum per annum from the date when such instalments became due.

Certain persors named in Schedule (2) to be permitted to complete their purchases. 3 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any repealed or existing Act regulating the sale or disposition of lands of the Crown, it shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands to permit the persons named in Schedule (2) to complete the purchase of the several areas of land set opposite to their names; and upon payment of the balance of purchase-money, in each instance, into the Treasury, together with a grant fee of Fifteen Shillings, the Governor is hereby authorised, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty, to convey and alienate the said lands to the said persons respectively, in fee simple, or for any less estate or interest.

Power to exchange certain land in Town of Smithton with Leslie William Brooks.

4 In consideration of Leslie William Brooks having surrendered to His Majesty all his right, title and interest in and to the land described in Schedule (3), it shall be lawful for the Governor, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty, to convey and alienate the land described in Schedule (4) to the said Leslie William Brooks, in fee simple, or for any less estate or interest.

Power to exchange certain land with Kenneth Montague Harrisson.
Schedules (5) and (6) and (7) and (8).

5 Upon Kenneth Montague Harrisson executing a surrender to His Majesty of the lands described in Schedules (5) and (6), it shall be lawful for the Governor, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty, to convey and alienate the Crown lands described in Schedules (7) and (8) to the said Kenneth Montague Harrisson, in fee simple, or for any less estate or interest.

Commissioner may sell certain land to *Emily Maud Rayner*. Schedule (9).

6 It shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands to sell by private contract to *Emily Maud Rayner* the lot of Crown land described in Schedule (9) for the sum of Five hundred Pounds; and upon payment of such sum of money, together with a grant fee of Fifteen Shillings, into the Treasury, the Governor is hereby authorised, in the name and behalf of His Majesty, to convey and alienate the said land to the said *Emily Maud Rayner*, in fee simple, or for any less estate or interest.

Commissioner may sell certain land to Hester C. Leatham.
Schedule (10).

7 It shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands to sell by private contract to *Hester Champton Leatham* the Crown land described in Schedule (10) for the sum of Eight hundred and twenty Pounds; and upon payment of such sum of money into the Treasury, together with a grant fee of Fifteen Shillings, the Governor is hereby authorised, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty, to convey and alienate the said land to the said *Hester Champton Leatham*, in fee simple, or for any less estate or interest.

8-(1) It shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands to A.D. 1921. grant to the liquidator of the Tasmania Gold Mine Limited (in liquidation) a special lease of the land described in Schedule (11) for a Power to Comterm of Five years at a yearly rental of Five Shillings.

(2) Such lease shall give to the said liquidator, or his assigns, a liquidator of the right to purchase the said lands at any time within the said term of Five years for the sum of Thirty-seven Pounds upon his complying

with the conditions to be therein contained.

(3) Such lease shall contain—

1. A covenant by the lessee to establish or procure the establishment of an industry or undertaking upon or in connection with the said land of such a nature and financial stability and with such amount of working capital as the

Governor may approve: and

II. A proviso that in the event of the lessee failing to comply with all or any of the provisions of such lease, or to exercise the said right of purchase, the Commissioner shall be at liberty to re-enter on the said lands and to purchase all the buildings thereon for the sum of Three thousand Pounds: and

III. Such other covenants, conditions, and provisos as the

Governor may approve.

(4) Upon the said liquidator exercising the said right of purchase as Power to sell. hereinbefore provided, and upon payment of the said sum of Thirtyseven Pounds, together with a grant fee of Fifteen Shillings, it shall be lawful for the Governor in the name and on behalf of His Majesty to convey and alienate the said lands to the said liquidator or his assigns in fee simple or for any less estate or interest.

9 Upon Herry Eric Brock, Harold J. Brock, and Claudius Power to Alexander Brock, surrendering to His Majesty all their right, title, exchange certain and interest in and to the land described in Schedules (12) and Lake with (13), being portion of the Split Rock Estate, it shall be lawful B_{rock} B_{rock} for the Governor in the name and on behalf of His Majesty to Schedules (12) to convey and alienate the lands described in Schedules (14) and (15) to Brock Bros. Proprietary Limited in fee simple, or for any less estate or interest, in lieu of the said land and in full satisfaction of all claims and demands for compensation by the said Henry Eric Brock, Harold J. Brock, and Cladius Alexander Brock, or any of them.
