

AN ACT to further amend The Real Property A.D. 1890. [28 November, 1890.] Act.

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend The Real Property PREAMBLE. 25 Vict. No. 16.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1 This Act may be cited as "The Real Property Act, No. 6."

Short title.

2 The words "any public right of way" are hereby inserted in Section Forty of The Real Property Act before the words "any right of way" at the end of the Thirteenth line thereof, and the said Section Section 16 shall be read and construed as if the words hereby inserted had always been inserted therein and originally formed part of the said Section.

3 The Real Property Act and every Act altering or amending the Acts to be read same shall, so far as the same may be altered or amended by this Act, together. and this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act.
