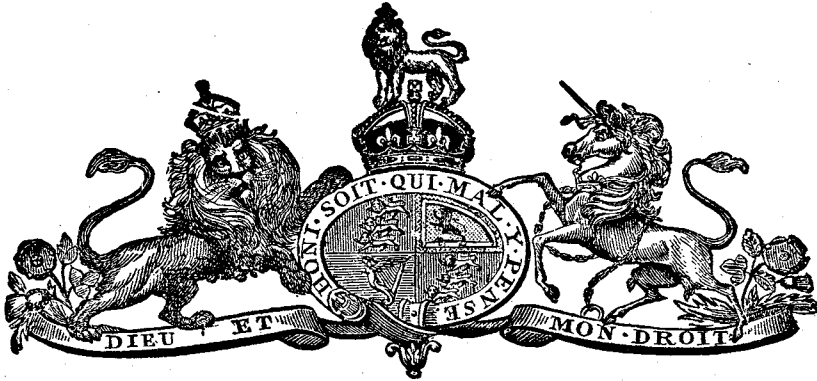

AN ACT to further amend "The Returned ^{A.D.} 1920.
Soldiers' Settlement Act, 1916."

[20 December, 1920.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Returned Soldiers' Settlement Act, 1920," and shall be incorporated and read as one with "The Returned Soldiers' Settlement Act, 1916" (hereinafter called "The Principal Act"), and any amendment thereof. Short title and incorporation with 7 Geo. V. No. 20.

Returned Soldiers' Settlement.

Amendment of
Section Two of
the Principal
Act.

2 Section Two of the Principal Act is hereby amended—

- i. By omitting from the definition of "Discharged soldier" contained in the said section the whole of Paragraph III. of such definition, including the proviso at the end of the said paragraph:
- ii. By inserting after Paragraph II.B. of such definition the following words:—"But the expression 'discharged soldier' shall not include any person whose discharge from service was due to misconduct or incapacity resulting from his own default."

Amendment of
Section Six of the
Principal Act.

3 Section Six of the Principal Act is hereby amended as from the commencement of that Act by omitting from Sub-section (1) the words "One million three hundred and fifty thousand," and substituting therefor the words "Two million three hundred and fifty thousand."

Amendment of
Section Seven of
the Principal
Act.

4 Section Seven of the Principal Act is hereby amended as from the commencement of that Act by omitting the words "four hundred" in Paragraph VII. of Subsection (2) thereof, and substituting therefor the words "four hundred and fifty."

Amendment of
Section Nine of
the Principal
Act.

5 Section Nine of the Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting after Subsection (9) thereof the following Subsection (10):—
“(10) Every lessee of land under this Act shall be deemed to be the owner thereof within the meaning of 'The Boundary Fences Act, 1908.'”

Modification of
proviso to Para-
graph IV. of
Section 23 of
2 Geo. V. No. 64
as applied to
discharged
soldiers.

6 For the purposes of the Principal Act the proviso to Paragraph IV. of Section Twenty-three of "The Crown Lands Act, 1911," shall be read as if the following words were inserted at the end of the proviso, namely, "unless the holder of such lease shall, by writing, consent to such sale, and for the purposes of this proviso a selection under Section Eleven of 'The Returned Soldiers' Settlement Act, 1916,' shall be deemed to be a sale."
