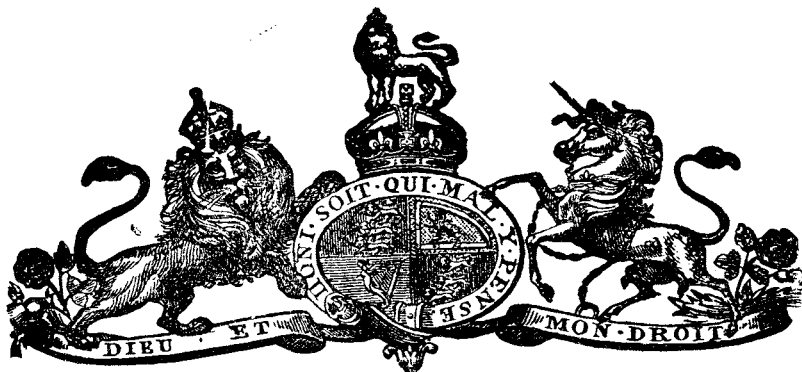

AN ACT to amend the Repairs to Roads Act, 1920. A.D. 1927.  
 [14 November, 1927.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as “The Repairs to Roads (Ringarooma Council) Act, 1927.” Short title.

(2) The Repairs to Roads Act, 1920, is herein called “the Act of 11 Geo.V. No. 19, 1920.”

**2** In this Act “the Council” means the Municipal Council of the Municipality of Ringarooma. Interpretation.

*Repairs to Roads (Ringarooma Council).*

Council to be discharged from liability under certain debentures.

**3**—(1) After the commencement of this Act no moneys shall be payable by the Council to the Treasurer (whether for principal or interest in respect of any debentures heretofore given by the Council to the Treasurer in pursuance of the Act of 1920, and which had not been redeemed prior to such commencement.

(2) The Council shall be freed and discharged from all liability in respect of such debentures as aforesaid, and the same shall be cancelled by the Treasurer, and, for the purpose of the Act of 1920, shall be deemed to have been redeemed at the time of the commencement of this Act.

No further payments to be made by Treasurer under Section 13 of the Act of 1920 in respect of moneys advanced to the Council under that Act.

**4** No further payment shall, after the commencement of this Act, be made under Section Thirteen of the Act of 1920, by the Treasurer out of the Consolidated Revenue to the credit of the Repairs to Roads Suspense Account (hereinafter called "the said Account") in respect of, or in relation to, any moneys heretofore advanced by the Treasurer to the Council under the Act of 1920, or in respect of, or in relation to, any debentures given by the Council to the Treasurer in respect of any portion of such moneys.

Treasurer to pay £3145 8s. 0d. to the credit of Suspense Account.

**5** The Treasurer shall, out of the Consolidated Revenue for the financial year which began on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, pay to the credit of the said account, without any authority other than this Act, the sum of Three thousand one hundred and forty-five Pounds Eight Shillings, such sum representing in the aggregate the principal moneys secured by such debentures as aforesaid, and a further amount which, but for this Act, would have been payable by the Treasurer out of the Consolidated Revenue to the credit of the said account under, and in the manner provided by, Section Thirteen of the Act of 1920.
