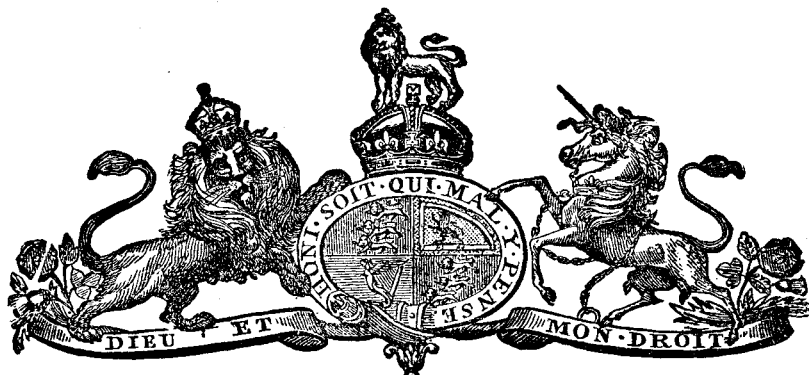

AN ACT to amend "The Ross Water Act, 1895."  
[14 February, 1922.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Ross Water Act, 1921."

Short title.

2 Section Forty-four of "The Ross Water Act, 1895," as amended by Section Two of "The Ross Water Act Amendment Act, 1905," is hereby repealed, and the following section is substituted in lieu thereof:—

"44 Such rate shall be called a water rate, and may be of any amount not exceeding the sum of Three Shillings in the Pound per annum on the assessed annual value of the property within the district, and except as is herein otherwise provided, all the provisions of "The Local Government Act, 1906," relating to the making, levying, collecting, and recovery of rates shall apply to the making, levying, collection, and recovery of every rate imposed under the authority of this Act.

"Provided that the water rate payable in respect of any house or dwelling within the water district shall in no case be less than Fifteen Shillings."
