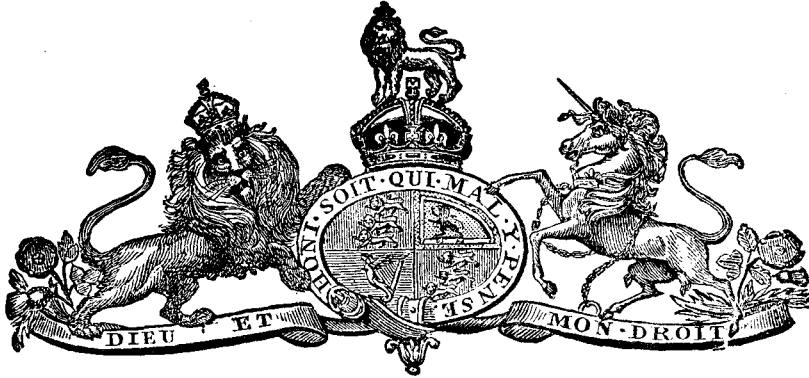

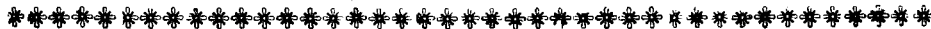

ANALYSIS.

1. Short title.
2. Minister may cause works to be executed.
3. Authority to Treasurer to borrow £25,000.



AN ACT to provide for the Execution of certain State Railway Works. [25 July, 1929.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Railway Works (Flood Damage) Execution Act, 1929.”

Railway Works (Flood Damage) Execution

2 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be undertaken, constructed, improved, executed, completed, carried out, and provided the various undertakings, works, purposes, and things set forth in the schedule to this Act at a total cost not exceeding the amount stated in that schedule.

Authority to
Treasurer to
borrow £25,000.

3 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to raise, borrow, and receive any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of Twenty-five thousand Pounds for the purposes of this Act.
