AN ACT to further amend "The Scab Act, A.D. 1880. 1875." [20 October, 1880.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The sum of money mentioned in the Twelfth Section of "The Contribution to Scab Act, 1875," may, if the Governor in Council sees fit, be increased "The Scab Act from a sum not exceeding One Farthing to any sum not exceeding One Fund" for 1881 Halfpenny for the year 1881 and no longer.

2 This Act and "The Scab Act, 1875," and every Act altering or Acts to be read amending the same, shall, as altered by this Act, be read and construed together. together as one Act.

3 This Act may be cited as "The Scab Act, 1880."
