AN ACT to further amend "The Scab Act, 1875." A.D. 1880.
[20 October, 1880.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The sum of money mentioned in the Twelfth Section of "The Scab Act, 1875," may, if the Governor in Council sees fit, be increased from a sum not exceeding One Farthing to any sum not exceeding One Halfpenny for the year 1881 and no longer. Contribution to "The Scab Act Fund" for 1881

2 This Act and "The Scab Act, 1875," and every Act altering or amending the same, shall, as altered by this Act, be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.

3 This Act may be cited as "The Scab Act, 1880." Short Title
