AN ACT to further amend "The Scab Act, A.D. 1883. 1875." [29 October, 1883.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

1 So much of the Forty fourth Section of "The Scab Act, 1875," Repeal. as provides for the punishment of persons driving Inland any imported 39 Vict. No. 20, Sheep until the same have been dipped in some effective Scab-destroying s. 44. preparation, is hereby repealed.

2 The Governor in Council may prescribe by Regulations made Regulations for under the said Act the conditions upon which imported Sheep may be landing Sheep. landed, and may appoint penalties for breach of or non-compliance with any such Regulation, not exceeding in any case the sum of Five Pounds; and any such penalty may be recovered under The Magistrates 19 Vict. No. 8. Summary Procedure Act.

3 "The Scab Act, 1875," as amended by this Act, and this Act, Acts to be read together. shall be read and construed together as one Act.

4 This Act may be cited as "The Scab Act, 1883."
