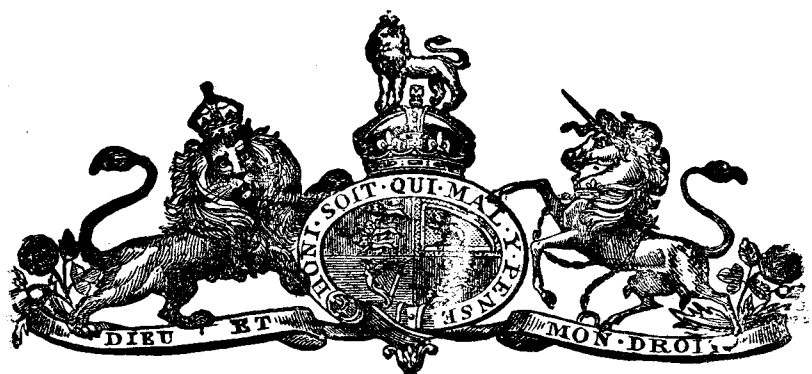

AN ACT to further amend "The State Advances Act, 1907." [23 December, 1916.] A.D. 1916.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The State Advances Act, 1916," and shall be incorporated and read as one with "The State Advances Act, 1907" (in this Act referred to as the Principal Act,) and every Act amending the same. Short title and incorporation with 7 Edw. VII. No. 20.

2 Section Eleven of the Principal Act (as amended by Section Two of "The State Advances Act, 1914", is hereby amended by omitting from Subsection (1) thereof the words "One hundred thousand Pounds," and substituting therefor the words "One hundred and fifty thousand Pounds" Amendment of Section 11 of Principal Act. 5 Geo. V. No. 34.

3 Section Twelve of the Principal Act is hereby amended by omitting therefrom the words "not exceeding the sum of Four Pounds per centum per annum."

4 Section Twenty of the Principal Act is hereby amended by omitting therefrom the words "not exceeding Four Pounds per centum per annum."

5 Section Twenty-three of the Principal Act is hereby amended by—

- i. Omitting therefrom the words "The rate of interest shall not exceed Six Pounds per centum per annum, and,"; and
- ii. Inserting immediately after the word "unpaid" occurring in the Third line thereof the words "at a rate to be determined by the Treasurer."
