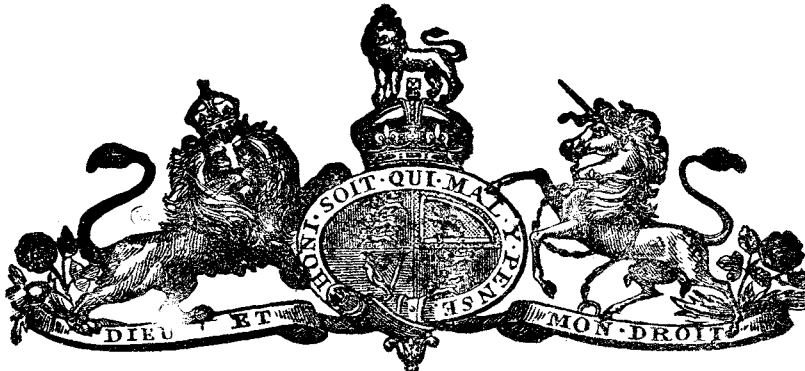

AN ACT to amend the State Advances Act, <sup>A.D.</sup> 1927.  
1907. [28 October, 1927.] —

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as “The State Advances Act, 1927.” Short title.  
 (2) The State Advances Act, 1907, is herein called “the Principal Act.” Principal Act.

**2**—(1) It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to appropriate and apply for the purposes of the Principal Act the sum of Twenty thousand Pounds, portion of the moneys authorised to be expended under and for the purposes of the Act 11 Geo. V. No. 37, and raised under the Act 11 Geo. V. No. 44. Reappropriation

11 Geo.V. No. 44.

(2) The said sum of Twenty thousand Pounds shall be placed to the credit of the trust account referred to in Section Eighteen of the Principal Act, and for the purposes of that section shall be deemed to be moneys raised under the Principal Act.
