

AN ACT to amend the State Advances Act, 1907. [25 July, 1929.]

A.D. 1929.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The State Advances Act, 1929."

2 The State Advances Act, 1907, is hereby amended—

I. By expunging Subsection (6) of Section Twenty-one thereof, Section 21 as inserted by the State Advances Act, 1912, and (6). amended, and substituting therefor the following new Subsection (6)—

"(6) No advance in respect of freehold land, shall exceed an amount equal to seven-tenths of the capital value of such land as estimated by the Board"and this amendment shall be deemed to have taken effect as from the fifteenth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine: and

II. By deleting the word "twenty-nine" at the end of Section Fifty-three thereof and substituting therefor the word "thirty."

Repeal of Section 5 of 18 Geo. V. No. 80, and Section 9 of 19 Geo. V. No. 50, 3 Section Five of the State Advances Act (No. 2), 1927, and Section Nine of the State Advances Act, 1928, are hereby repealed.
