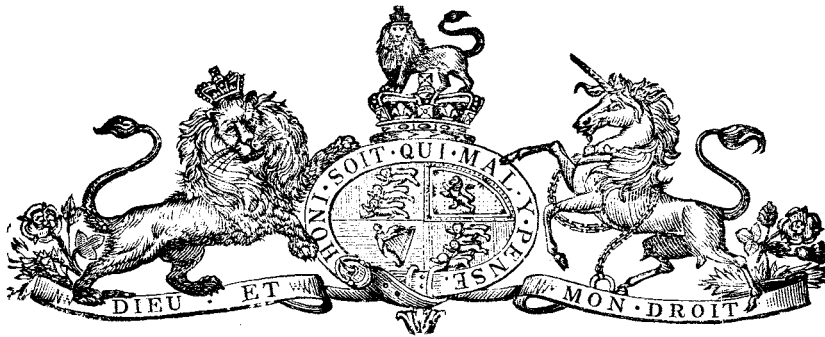

AN ACT to amend the State Advances Act,
 1907. [3 August, 1931.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

- 1** This Act may be cited as “The State Advances Act, 1931.” Short title.
- 2** Section Forty-two of the State Advances Act, 1907, is hereby amended— Amendment of 7 Ed. VII. No. 20, s. 42.
 - i.** By expunging Subsections (4) and (5): and (Inserted by 19 Geo. V. No. 50, s. 10.)
 - ii.** By deleting the word “Five” in the first line of Subsection (9) and substituting therefor the word “Ten”.
- 3** This Act shall be in operation until the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-two. Limitation of Act.
