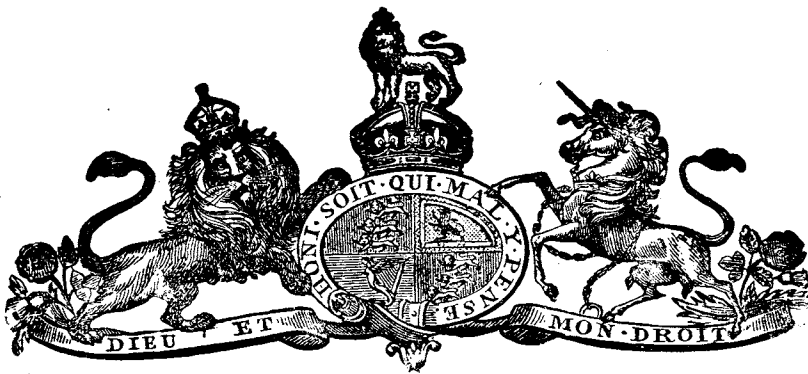

AN ACT to amend "The Statutes Compilation
Act, 1912." [5 December, 1913.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Statutes Compilation Act, 1913," and shall have effect as from the commencement of "The Statutes Compilation Act, 1912" (hereinafter called "the Principal Act").

2 Section Two of the Principal Act is hereby amended—

1. By the omission of the words "so soon as may be possible after the termination of the session in which such resolution was passed":

- ii. By the insertion in the Tenth line of the section, between the word "Acts" and the word "with," of the words "and all amendments of the Act which have been made otherwise than by direct alteration of or addition to the text thereof."

**Amendment of
Section 3 of
Principal Act.**

3 Section Three of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the omission of the words "who shall respectively lay the same on the table at the commencement of the next succeeding session," and by the insertion, in lieu thereof, of the words "each of whom shall lay the copy so forwarded to him on the table of his House."
