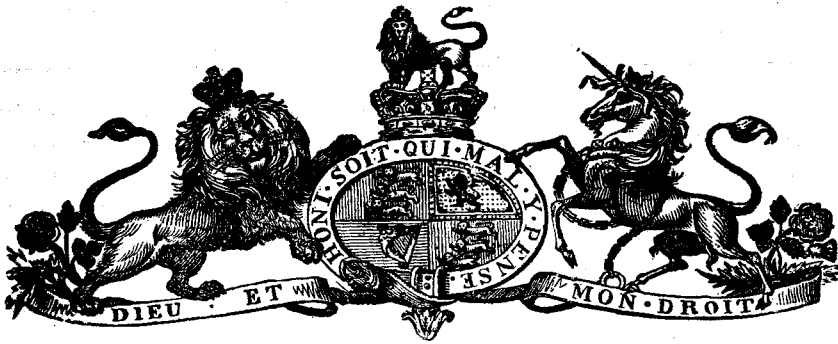

AN ACT to further amend *The Sorell Causeway Act.* [21 December, 1871.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend *The Sorell Causeway Act*: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of **Tasmania**, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

PREAMBLE.
24 Vict. No. 27.

1 So much of Section Thirteen of *The Sorell Causeway Act* as provides that no Plans and Specifications shall be approved by the Governor in Council which do not provide for some Drawbridge or moveable platform in mid-channel giving a clear opening of not less than Thirty-five feet at the least for the passage of steam boats and masted vessels through the Causeway mentioned in the said Act, is hereby repealed.

Repeal of part of Sect. 13 of 24 Vict. No. 27.

2 This Act and all other Acts altering or amending *The Sorell Causeway Act* shall, save so far as the said Acts or any of them may be altered or amended by this Act, be read and construed together as one Act.

Acts to be read together.

3 This Act may be cited as "The Sorell Causeway Act, No. 4." **Short Title.**
