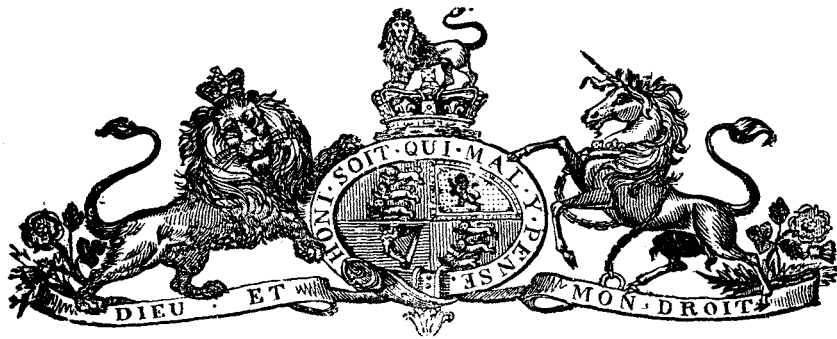

AN ACT to further amend "The Small Debts Act." A.D. 1874.
[18 September, 1874.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to extend the jurisdiction of the Courts held under "The Small Debts Act:" PREAMBLE.
31 Vict. No. 15.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The Governor in Council may from time to time, by notice published in the *Gazette*, increase the amount to which the jurisdiction of any Court now or hereafter appointed under "The Small Debts Act" is or shall be limited, to an amount not exceeding Fifty Pounds. Amount to which jurisdiction of Courts is limited may be increased.

2 The Governor in Council is hereby empowered from time to time to appoint Courts to be held before a Commissioner for the recovery of debts and demands under the said Act, to such an amount not exceeding Fifty Pounds, and at such places and times, as the Governor in Council thinks fit. Courts of Requests may be appointed having jurisdiction to £50.

3 This Act and the said Act, and every Act altering and amending the same, shall, save as altered or amended by this Act, be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.

4 This Act may be cited as "The Small Debts Act Amendment, 1874." Short title.
