

AN ACT to further amend "The Small Debts A.D. 1874. [18 September, 1874.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to extend the jurisdiction of the Courts PREAMBLE. held under "The Small Debts Act:"

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The Governor in Council may from time to time, by notice Amount to which published in the Gazette, increase the amount to which the juris-jurisdiction of diction of any Court now or hereafter appointed under "The Small may be increased. Debts Act" is or shall be limited, to an amount not exceeding Fifty Pounds.

- 3 This Act and the said Act, and every Act altering and amending Acts to be read the same, shall, save as altered or amended by this Act, be read and together. construed together as one Act.
- 4 This Act may be cited as "The Small Debts Act Amendment, Short title. 1874."
