

AN ACT to amend "The Stamp Duties A.D. 1886. Act, 1882." [8 *December*, 1886.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 A Bill of Exchange or Promissory Note purporting to be drawn Bills, &c. puror made out of *Tasmania* is, for the purposes of "The Stamp Duties porting to be Act, 1882," to be deemed to have been so drawn or made, although it drawn, &c. abroad may in fact have been drawn or made within Tasmania.

- 2 The Stamp Duty under the said Act for and in respect of a Foreign 33 & 34 Vict. Promissory Note is the same as on an Inland Note of the same amount c. 97, s. 32. and tenor, and such Duty is payable by the payee of such Foreign Note: Provided that the Manager of any Bank may stamp any such Note in like manner as is provided in Section Twelve of the said Act

  Duty on Foreign Promissory Notes. with reference to Foreign Bills of Exchange drawn out of the Colony.
- 3 The said Act, as amended by this Act, and this Act, shall be read Acts to be read together. and construed together as one Act.
- 4 This Act may be cited as "The Stamp Duties Amendment Act, Short title. 1886."
