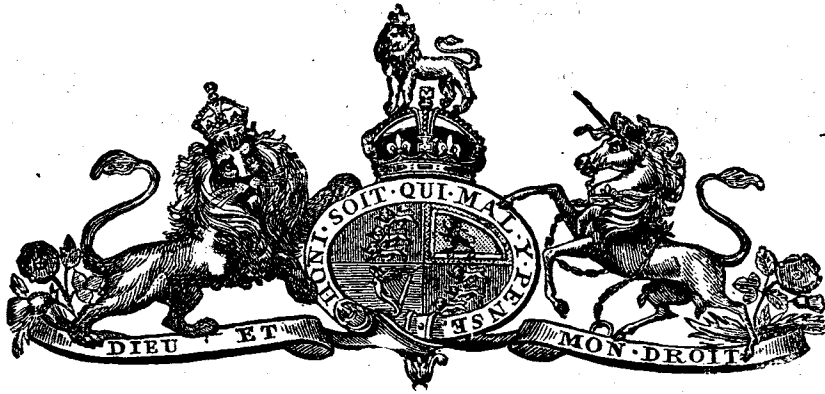

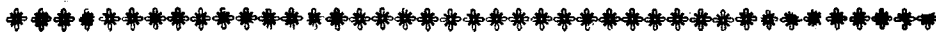

AN ACT to amend "The Stamp Duties ^{A.D.} 1916.
Amendment Act, 1904." [23 December, 1916.] —

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may for all purposes be cited as "The Stamp Duties Short title. Amendment Act, 1916."

2 This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Commencement Proclamation.

3 Schedule (2) to "The Stamp Duties Amendment Act, 1904," is hereby amended by omitting therefrom the words "For every Lottery Ticket," and all the words of the said schedule occurring after such words, and substituting therefor the following :—
