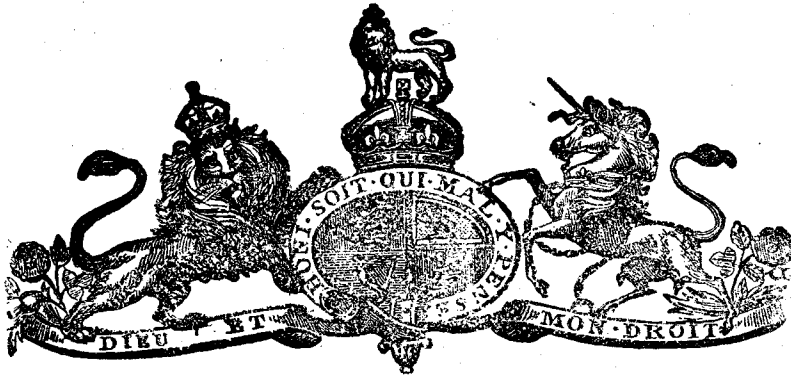

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act may be cited as "The Stamp Duties Amendment Act, 1920." Short title.

**2** The Acts mentioned in the Schedule to this Act are hereby repealed to the extent specified in the Third column of that Schedule. Repeal of Acts.
