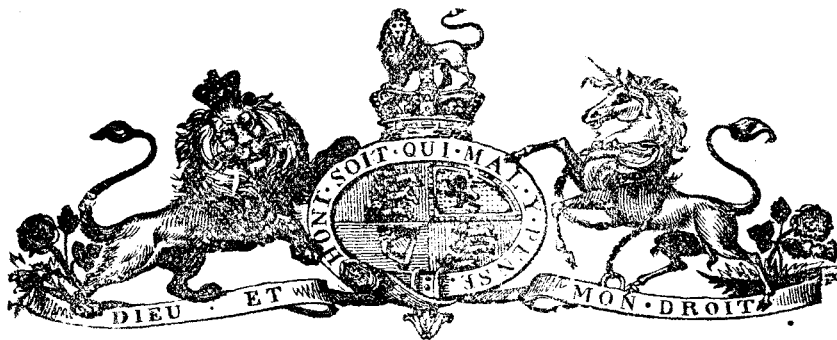

AN ACT to further amend "The Stamp Duties Act, 1870." [20 October, 1880.] A.D. 1880.

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend "The Stamp Duties Act, 1870:": PREAMBLE.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 For and in respect of the several instruments, matters, and things described and mentioned in the Schedule there shall be raised, levied, and paid the several Duties set down in figures against the same respectively, and such Duties shall be paid by the persons named in the Third column of the said Schedule; anything contained in "The Stamp Duties Act, 1870," or the Schedule (1) thereto, or any Act amending the said Act, to the contrary notwithstanding. Duties in respect of certain instruments.

2 This Act and "The Stamp Duties Act, 1870," and every Act amending the same, shall, as amended by this Act, be read together as one Act. Acts to be read together.

3 This Act may be cited as "The Stamp Duties Amendment Act, No. 2." Short title.

*Exemption from the foregoing Duties.*

Any instrument appointing a proxy under "The Bankruptcy Act, 1870," or any General Rules made thereunder, or under any Act relating to Insolvent Debtors.
