

AN ACT to amend "The *St. Helen's Water Act, 1892.*" [14 November, 1893.] A.D. 1893.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The *St. Helen's Water Act, 1892,*" in the manner hereinafter appearing : PREAMBLE.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania,* by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The *St. Helen's Water Act, 1893.*" Short title.

2 In this Act the expression "the said Act" shall mean "The *St. Helen's Water Act, 1892,*" and "Trustees" shall mean the Trustees elected under the provisions of the said Act. Interpretation.

3 It shall be lawful for the Government to guarantee the payment of the interest upon any moneys not exceeding in all the sum of Two thousand five hundred Pounds which may be borrowed by the Trustees under the provisions of the said Act for the purposes of the said Act : Provided always that in every case in which, and so far as the Government in consequence of any guarantee advances and pays any sum of money payable as interest on any moneys borrowed by the Trustees for the purposes of the said Act, all moneys so paid by the Government shall be and the same are hereby declared to be a primary charge upon the Rates to be received by the Trustees under the provisions of the said Act. Government may guarantee interest on loan.

4 This Act and the said Act shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.
