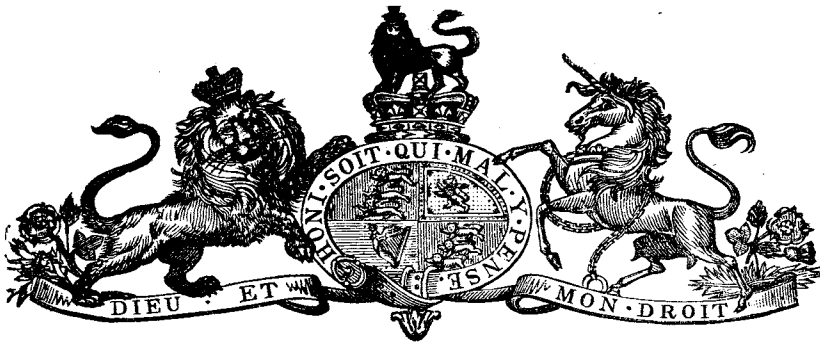

AN ACT to further amend "The *St. Helen's* Water Act, 1892." [25 August, 1894.] *see vic No 31*

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The *St. Helen's* Water Act, 1892," in the manner hereinafter appearing :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The *St. Helen's* Water Act, 1894." Short title.

2 In this Act the following words and expressions shall have the meanings hereinafter respectively assigned to them ; (that is to say)— Interpretation.

"The said Act" shall mean "The *St. Helen's* Water Act, 1892:"

"The Trustees" shall mean the Trustees for the time being of the *St. Helen's* Water District elected under the said Act.

3 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council from time to time to grant to the Trustees, as a loan or loans for carrying out the objects of the said Act, any sum or sums of money not exceeding in all the sum of Two thousand five hundred Pounds (£2500), under and subject to the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," and Governor in Council may lend to Trustees.

upon the Governor in Council granting such loan or loans to the Trustees, the power conferred upon the Trustees by Section Seventy-one of the said Act to borrow the sum of money therein mentioned shall cease and determine.

Acts to be read
together.

4 This Act and the said Act, and every Act amending the said Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act.
