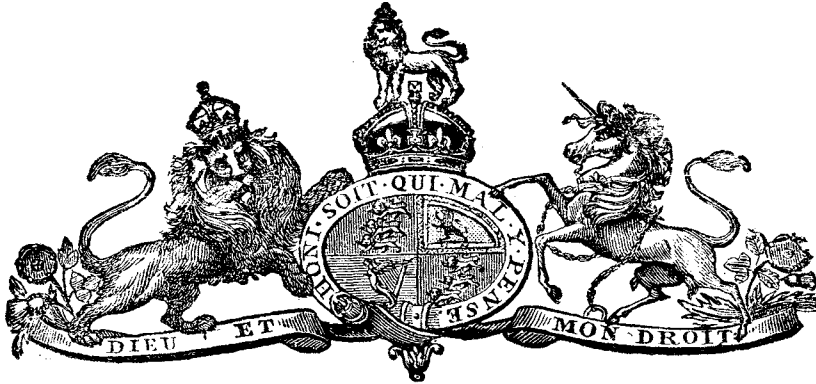

AN ACT to authorise the Loan of Two thousand two hundred and fifty Pounds to the Warden, Councillors, and Electors of the Municipality of Kentish in accordance with the provisions of the State Loans to Local Bodies Act, 1921, for the purpose of providing for Lighting portion of the said Municipality by Electricity, and for other purposes.

**W**HEREAS the Warden, councillors and electors of the Municipality of Kentish are desirous of entering into an agreement with the Minister controlling the Hydro-Electric Department for the

purchase and supply to Sheffield of electrical energy, in bulk, and to carry out the necessary works required in connection therewith, in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Amendment Act, 1924 :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act is divided into three parts, as follows :—

- I. Preliminary.
- II. Power to borrow.
- III. Poll.

## PART I.

## PRELIMINARY

Short title and incorporation.

**2** This Act may be cited as “The Sheffield Lighting Act, 1925,” and shall be read as part of, and deemed to be incorporated with, the Local Government Act, 1906.

Commencement of Act.

**3** This Act shall commence and take effect on a day to be appointed by proclamation.

Interpretation

**4** In this Act and in any by-laws or rules made, unless the context otherwise determines :—

“Council” means the Municipal Council of the Municipality of Kentish :

“Elector” means every person, being a natural-born or naturalized subject of His Majesty, and whether male or female, of or above the age of Twenty-one years, whose name as owner or occupier of any property within the light district appears on the Assessment Roll :

“Electrical Energy” means and includes electrical current and electrical power .

“Corporation” means the Warden, councillors, and electors of the Municipality of Kentish.

## PART II.

## POWER TO BORROW.

Power to borrow.

**5** It shall be lawful for the Council on behalf of the Corporation to raise by way of loan, under the provisions of the State Loans to Local Bodies Act, 1921, any sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole the sum of Two thousand two hundred and fifty Pounds, for the purpose of defraying the cost of the works necessary for the distribution of electrical energy in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Amendment Act, 1924.

**6** The amount payable by the Council as an annual contribution towards a sinking fund in respect of any money borrowed under this Act shall be an amount equal to Two Pounds Five Shillings per centum of the moneys so borrowed. A.D. 1925.  
Sinking fund.

**7** It shall be lawful for the Treasurer of the State of Tasmania to borrow, raise, and receive a total sum of Two thousand two hundred and fifty Pounds for the purpose of this Act. Treasurer authorised to raise £2250.

**PART III.****POLL.**

**8** Before any money is borrowed under this Act the Council shall take a poll of electors in the power area in accordance with the provisions of the State Loans to Local Bodies Act, 1921, and a majority of the valid votes polled being in the affirmative shall be deemed to be sufficient for the purpose of this Act. Poll of electors to be taken.
