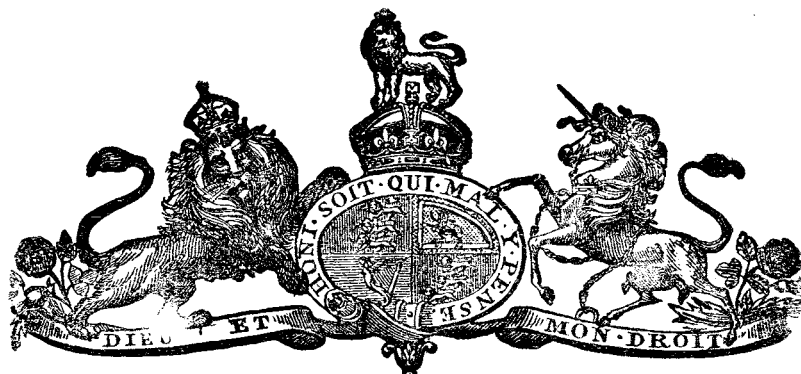

1. Short title.
2. Time for borrowing extended.

AN ACT to amend the Stanley Lighting Act, 1924. [17 September, 1926.]

A.D. 1926.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “ The Stanley Lighting Act, 1926.” Short title

2 Notwithstanding the provisions of Section Twenty-four of the State Loans to Local Bodies Act, 1921, the Council may borrow the whole or any part of the moneys authorised by the Stanley Lighting Act, 1924, to be borrowed at any time within four years from the commencement of the lastmentioned Act. Time for borrowing extended.
