

TASMANIAN SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA (FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE) ACT 1987

No. 36 of 1987

AN ACT to provide for the making of contributions by the State and by municipalities for the support of the Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra and to repeal the Tasmanian Orchestra (Agreement) Act 1948.

[Royal Assent 8 May 1987]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the Tasmanian Symphony Short title. Orchestra (Financial Assistance) Act 1987.

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives Commencement. the Royal assent.

3—In this Act—

Interpretation.

"Corporation" means the body corporate continued in existence by force of section 5 (1) of the Australian Broadcasting Corporation Act 1983 of the Commonwealth under the name of the Australian Broadcasting Corporation;

"orchestra" means the orchestra known as the Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra that is managed and controlled by the Corporation.

State contribution towards support of orchestra.

- 4—(1) The Minister may enter into an agreement with the Corporation to pay towards the support of the orchestra an amount of \$90 000 in each financial year in the period beginning 1st July 1987 and ending on 30th June 1990.
- (2) Each amount payable under subsection (1) shall be paid by the Treasurer out of the Consolidated Fund and the amount so payable is accordingly, by virtue of this subsection, appropriated to the extent necessary.

Power of municipalities to make contributions towards support of orchestra. 5—Notwithstanding anything in the Local Government Act 1962, the Hobart Corporation Act 1963, or the Launceston Corporation Act 1963, a municipality may make contributions out of its municipal fund towards the support of the orchestra.

Repeal of Tasmanian Orchestra (Agreement) Act 1948 and matters consequential on that repeal.

- 6—(1) The Tasmanian Orchestra (Agreement) Act 1948 is repealed.
- (2) On and after the day on which this Act receives the Royal assent—
 - (a) any agreement executed pursuant to section 3 of the Tasmanian Orchestra (Agreement) Act 1948 ceases to have any force or effect;
 - (b) anything done under such an agreement before that day is not prejudiced or affected by the repeal of that Act:
 - (c) any rights that could be exercised by a person under such an agreement that were not exercised by him before that day may not be exercised by that person; and
 - (d) any obligations that could be imposed on a person under such an agreement that were not imposed on him before that day may not be imposed on that person.
