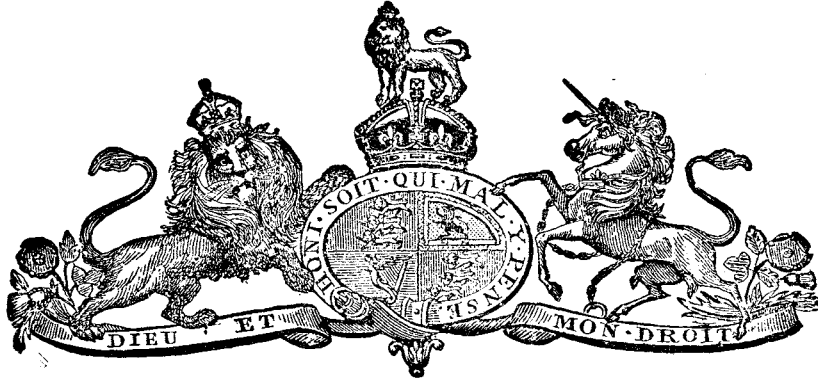

AN ACT to amend the Law relating to General Sessions of the Peace. [2 December, 1924.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Sessions of the Peace Act, 1924.” Short title.

2 No Court of General or Quarter Sessions of the Peace shall hereafter be holden for the District of Hobart, or the District of Launceston, unless specially summoned by the Clerk of the Peace for the district, to deal with some matter of which it has cognizance.

Courts of General Sessions not to be holden at Hobart or Launceston unless specially summoned.
