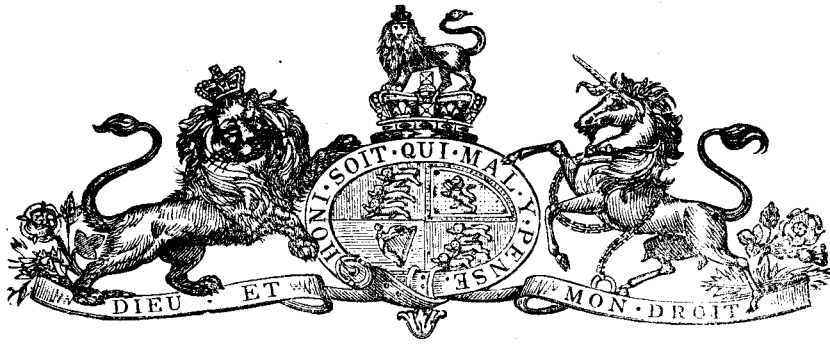

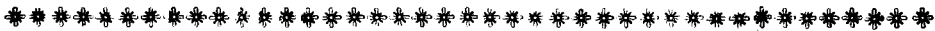

AN ACT to provide for the Construction of A.D. 1890.
certain Public Works, and Purchase of
certain Machinery. [28 November, 1890.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being to cause to be constructed, completed, improved, or executed, the Works mentioned in the Schedule, at a cost not exceeding the amount set forth in the said Schedule. Works to be constructed.

2 It shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being to cause to be purchased the Machinery mentioned in the Schedule, at a cost not exceeding the amount set forth in the said Schedule. Machinery to be purchased.

3 The cost of such Works and Machinery as specified in the said Schedule shall be defrayed out of the moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose. Defrayment of cost of Works.

4 All the provisions contained in "The Public Works Construction Act, 1880," shall extend and apply to the Works mentioned in the Schedule to this Act, as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act. Provisions of 44 Vict. No. 32 applied.
