

AN ACT to empower Local Boards of Health A.D. 1887. to levy a Rate for Sanitary Purposes. [20 December, 1887.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Sanitary Rate Act, 1887."

Short Title.

2 In the construction and for the purposes of this Act—

Interpretation.

"Local Board" or "Local Board of Health" shall mean the Municipal Councils of the City of Hobart, of the Town of Launceston, and of every Rural Municipality.

3 For the purpose of raising a sum of money to carry out the Rate may be provisions of "The Public Health Act, 1885," the Local Boards of levied by Local Health of the City of Hobart and Town of Launceston and of all Rural Municipalities in Tasmania may in the year 1888 and every succeeding year make and levy a Rate, not exceeding the sum of Sixpence in the Pound for any one year, upon the annual value of property throughout such City or Town or Rural Municipality, as shown by the Assessment Rolls in force in such City and Town and Rural Municipality.

Sanitary Rate.

Notice of Rate to be given.

4 Upon the making of a Rate by every such Local Board as aforesaid a Notice, signed by the Chairman and not less than Three Members of the Board, specifying the amount in the Pound of the Rate, the purpose and period for which the same is payable, shall be published in the Hohart Gazette; and upon any such Notice being so published the Rate therein mentioned shall be payable and paid at the times specified in such Notice by the persons liable to pay the same as shown by the Assessment Roll then in force in the City or Town or Rural Municipality where the Rate is made; and it shall not be necessary in any such Notice to set forth the names of the persons liable to the payment of the Rate, or the sums which according to such Rate such persons are liable to pay, or any other particulars than hereinbefore in that behalf mentioned.

Rate to be payable in advance.

5 Any such Rate as aforesaid shall be payable in advance in the same manner as any Municipal Rate, and at such periods as every such Local Board may from time to time appoint.

Rate how recoverable.

6 If any person liable as herein provided to pay any amount of Rates neglects to pay the same within due time after the same has been lawfully demanded, the Local Board may recover the amount due from such person in the same manner as any Municipal Rate is recoverable.
