

AN ACT to amend the State Road Construction Plant Purchase Act, 1926.

[22 December, 1928.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as "The State Road Construction Short title. Plant Purchase Act, 1928."
- (2) The State Road Construction Plant Purchase Act, 1926, is Principal Act. herein called "the Principal Act." 17 Geo. V. No. 19.

State Road Construction Plant Purchase (No. 2).

A.D. 1928.

Minister may cause machinery, &c., mentioned in the schedules to be purchased for State road construction plant.

- 2—(i) It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be purchased, provided, and acquired the machinery, vehicles, tools, appliances, and apparatus mentioned in Schedules (1) and (2) to this Act (hereinafter called "the said schedules"), at a cost therefor not exceeding in each case the amount for the same set forth in the said schedules.
- (2) All machinery, vehicles, tools, appliances, and apparatus which shall be purchased, provided, or acquired by the Minister under Subsection (1) of this section shall, when so purchased, provided, or acquired, be deemed, for the purposes of Sections Eight, Nine, and Ten of the Principal Act, to form part of the plant referred to in those sections.
- (3) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, if the whole or any portion of the money voted by this Act for or in respect of any item mentioned in either of the said schedules is not required to be expended upon that item, it shall be lawful for the Minister to expend such unexpended money, as he shall think fit, upon such one or more of the other items mentioned in the said schedules, or upon such other article of a similar nature to any of such other items, or which may be suitable for the purposes of, or convenient for use in connection with, the aforesaid plant.

Treasurer authorised to borrow £12,439.

- 3—(1) It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to borrow, raise, and receive a total sum not exceeding Twelve thousand four hundred and thirty-nine Pounds for the purposes of this Act.
- (2) All moneys borrowed and raised under this Act shall, for the purposes of Section Ten of the Principal Act, be deemed to have been borrowed and raised under that Act.

Amendment of Paragraph 1. of Section 10 of the Principal Act.

- **4** Paragraph 1. of Section Ten of the Principal Act is hereby amended as from the commencement of that Act by expunging Subparagraph (b) thereof and substituting the following Subparagraph (b) therefor:—
 - "(b) The amount of all sinking fund contributions payable in respect of the moneys last aforesaid: and."
