

# AN ACT to amend the State Road Construc-

AN ACT to amend the State Road Construc- 1927. tion Plant Purchase Act, 1926. [29 November, 1927]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as "The State Road Construction Short title. Plant Purchase Act (No. 2), 1927."

(2) The State Road Construction Plant Purchase Act, 1926, is Principal Act. herein called "the Principal Act." 17 Geo.V. No. 19.

## State Road Construction Plant Purchase (No. 2).

A.D. 1927.

Minister may cause machinery, &c., mentioned in the schedule to be purchased for State road construction plant

- 2—(1) It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be purchased, provided, and acquired the machinery, vehicles, tools, appliances, and apparatus mentioned in the schedule to this Act (hereafter called "the said schedule"), at a cost therefor not exceeding in each case the amount for the same set forth in the said schedule
- (2) All machinery, vehicles, tools, appliances, and apparatus which shall be purchased, provided, or acquired by the Minister under Subsection (1) of this section shall, when so purchased, provided, or acquired, be deemed, for the purposes of Sections Eight, Nine, and Ten of the Principal Act, to form part of the plant referred to in those sections.
- (3) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, if the whole or any portion of the money voted by this Act for or in respect of any item mentioned in the said schedule is not required to be expended upon that item, it shall be lawful for the Minister to expend such unexpended money upon such one or more of the other items mentioned in the said schedule as he shall think fit.

- 3 Nothing contained in the Public Works Committee Act, 1914, shall apply in respect of the purchase, provision, or acquisition of any machinery or other article or thing mentioned in the said schedule.
- 4—(1) It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to borrow, raise, and receive a total sum not exceeding Twenty-five thousand five hundred Pounds for the purposes of this Act.
- (2) All moneys borrowed and raised under this Act shall, for the purposes of Section Ten of the Principal Act, be deemed to have been borrowed and raised under that Act.

Annual appropriation of £3187 for sinking fund to redeem loan,

- 5—(1) Out of the Consolidated Revenue there shall be paid to the Commissioners the yearly sum of Three thousand one hundred and eighty-seven Pounds as a contribution towards a sinking fund for the purpose of redeeming the moneys borrowed and raised under this Act.
- (2) The said yearly sum shall be paid from the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, and shall be continued until the said sum of Twenty-five thousand five hundred Pounds is fully redeemed.

Investment of moneys.

(3) The Commissioners may invest all or any of the moneys received by them out of the Consolidated Revenue under the provisions of this Act, and the interest or other profit on any such moneys, in such securities as the Governor shall from time to time prescribe as securities in which investments may be made by them as such Commissioners.

Application of sinking fund.

(4) The moneys standing to the credit of such sinking fund, when sufficient for that purpose, shall be applied in the redemption of the moneys so borrowed and raised as aforesaid.

State Road Construction Plant Purchase (No. 2).

6 Paragraph 1. of Section Ten of the Principal Act is hereby A.D. 1927. amended by deleting the words "under this Act" in the second line of Subparagraph (b) of the said paragraph, and substituting the words "in respect of such moneys" therefor.

Amendment of Section 10 of the Principal Act.

7 Notwithstanding anything contained in Section One of the Date of com-Principal Act, that Act shall be deemed to have come into operation mencement of on the twenty-fourth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six.
