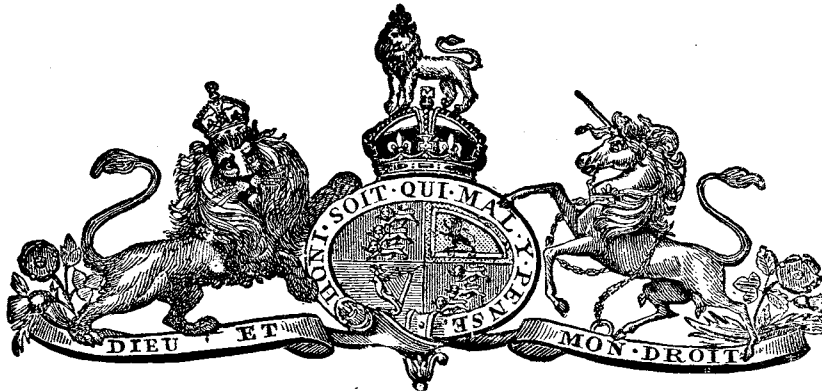

AN ACT to amend "The State Securities Act, 1918." A.D. 1924.
[2 December, 1924.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as "The State Securities Act, 1924." Short title.
 (2) "The State Securities Act, 1918," is herein called "the Principal Act." Principal Act,

2 Section Six of the Principal Act is hereby amended by deleting the words "payable out of the proceeds of such loan" occurring in the last line of the said Section, and substituting therefor the words "defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose." Amendment of

3 Section Nine of the Principal Act is hereby amended as follows :—

- i. As to Subsection (1) thereof, by deleting the words and brackets “(including the costs, charges and expenses incurred)” occurring in the eighth and ninth lines of the said subsection : and
- ii. As to Subsection (2) thereof, by deleting the comma after the word “securities” in the fourth line of the said subsection, and the words “and defraying the costs, charges, and expenses in so doing” occurring in such fourth line.
