AN ACT to amend the Tasmanian State Service Act 1984. [Royal Assent 9 May 1986]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:---

1—This Act may be cited as the *Tasmanian State Service Amend*- Short title. ment Act 1986.

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the Commence-Royal assent. No. 41

Principal Act.

Amendment of section 68 of Principal Act

(Procedure, &c., of appeal).

3—In this Act, the *Tasmanian State Service Act* 1984* is referred to as the Principal Act.

4-Section 68 of the Principal Act is amended as follows:-

(a) by omitting subsection (3) and substituting the following subsection:—

- (3) The Commissioner for Review may—
 - (a) in the case of a prescribed appeal, determine the appeal without holding a hearing; and
 - (b) in the case of any other appeal, if the Commissioner for Review and the parties to the appeal agree, determine the appeal without holding a hearing.
- (b) by omitting subsection (8) and substituting the following subsection:—

(8) A party to an appeal is entitled to tender written evidence to the Commissioner for Review and, where the Commissioner for Review conducts an appeal by holding a hearing, a party to the appeal is entitled to examine any person who tenders evidence at those proceedings.

- (c) by omitting from subsection (9) "A party to proceedings before the Commissioner for Review " and substituting "Where the Commissioner for Review conducts an appeal by holding a hearing, a party to the proceedings relating to the hearing ";
- (d) by adding after subsection (21) the following subsection:—

(22) For the purposes of this section, "prescribed appeal" means an appeal relating to the filling of a vacancy in a position listed in Parts I, II, or III of Schedule 5 to the *Tasmanian State Service Regulations* 1985.
