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**AN ACT to amend the Tasmanian State Service (Miscellaneous
Amendments) Act 1984.**

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Tasmanian State Service (Miscellaneous Amendments) Amendment Act (No. 2) 1985*. Short title.

2—This Act shall commence on the day fixed under section 2 (2) of the *Tasmanian State Service (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 1984*. Commencement.

3—Schedule 1 to the *Tasmanian State Service (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 1984** is amended as follows:—

(a) by inserting after paragraph (e) of item 1 of the amendments relating to the *Retirement Benefits Act 1982* the following paragraph:—

(ea) by omitting “include a permanent part-time employee” at the end of the definition of “employee” and substituting “include—

(p) a permanent part-time employee; or

(q) a person—

(i) who becomes an employee, within the meaning of the *Tasmanian State Service Act 1984*, by operation of the *Tasmanian State Service (Transitional Provisions) Act 1984*, and who immediately before he became such an employee was a participant in or a member of a scheme which is prescribed in the regulations; or

(ii) who becomes an employee, within the meaning of the *Tasmanian State Service Act 1984* after the commencement of that Act and becomes eligible to participate in or be a member of a scheme which is prescribed in the regulations unless he elects to be deemed to be an employee for the purposes of this Act.
