RE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—This Act may be cited as the Tasmanian State Service (Miscel-Short title. lancous Amendments) Amendment Act (No. 2) 1985.
- **2**—This Act shall commence on the day fixed under section 2 (2) Commenceof the Tasmanian State Service (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 1984.

- (a) by inserting after paragraph (e) of item 1 of the amendments relating to the Retirement Benefits Act 1982 the following paragraph:—
 - (ea) by omitting "include a permanent part-time employee" at the end of the definition of "employee" and substituting "include—
 - (p) a permanent part-time employee; or
 - (q) a person—
 - (i) who becomes an employee, within the meaning of the Tasmanian State Service Act 1984, by operation of the Tasmanian State Service (Transitional visions) Act 1984, and who immediately before he became such employee was a participant in or a member of a scheme which is prescribed in the regulations: or
 - (ii) who becomes an employee, within the meaning of Tasmanian State Service Act 1984 after the commencement of that Act and becomes eligible to participate in or be a member of a scheme which is prescribed in the regulations unless he elects to be deemed to be an employee for the purposes of this Act.

(b) by omitting paragraphs (b), (c), and (d) of item 2 of the amendments relating to the Retirement Benefits Act 1982.
