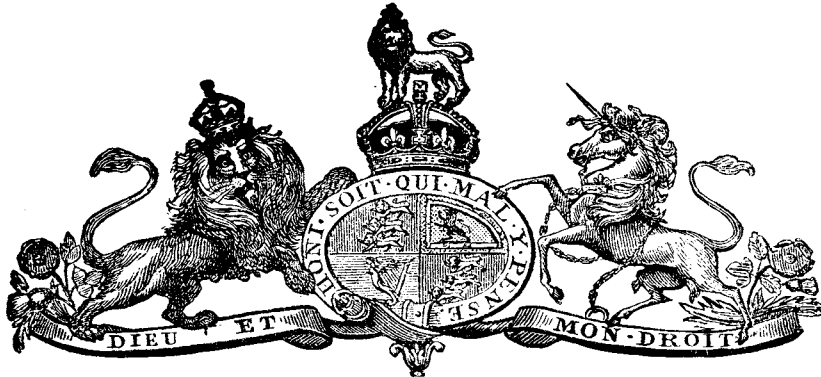

AN ACT to amend the Traffic Act, 1925.

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act may be cited as “ The Traffic Act, 1929.” Short title.

**2** The Traffic Act, 1925, is hereby amended by inserting after Paragraph xv. of Subsection (1) of Section Fifteen thereof the following new Paragraph xvi.— Amendment of  
16 Geo. V. No. 38,  
s. 15.

“ xvi. Prescribing generally or in respect of any area or part of the State or in respect of any route or journey the maximum and minimum fares, or either, which may be charged for the conveyance of any passenger in any coach or omnibus or public vehicle carrying passengers for hire between specified points, with power to discriminate between different areas, localities, or parts of the State or between different routes according to the circumstances of each particular case.”
