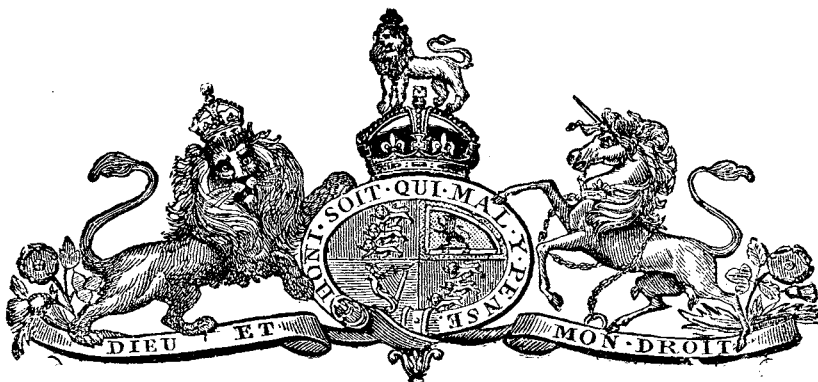

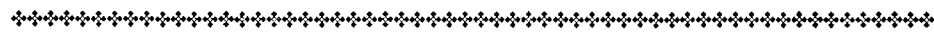

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AN ACT to amend the Town Boards Act, 1896. A.D. 1930.
[23 December, 1930.] —

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Town Boards Act, 1930.” Short title.

2 The Town Boards Act, 1896, is hereby amended by repealing Section One hundred and eighty-six thereof and substitut- Amendment of 60 Vict. No. 31.

ing therefor the following new Section One hundred and eighty-six:—

“186—(1) The amount certified as provided by Section One hundred and eighty-five hereof, in respect of any private street, or such part thereof as the council of the municipality in which such town as aforesaid is situate may determine, shall be payable to such council by the owners of the lands fronting or abutting on such private street in proportion to the frontages of their respective lands on such street.

(2) The amount of such proportion which shall be payable by each such owner shall be notified in writing by the council to the owner by whom the same is payable, and, except as hereinafter provided, shall be payable by such owner forthwith.

(3) At the request in writing of any such owner, lodged with the council within one month after such notification as aforesaid or within such further time, if any, as the council in any case may allow, the council shall accept payment of the proportion of the cost of construction payable by such owner by twenty equal annual instalments, commencing at such time, not later than one month after such request is made, as the council in each case may require.

(4) All moneys payable to the council as aforesaid shall bear interest from the date on which the same become payable respectively at such rate, not exceeding Seven Pounds per centum per annum, upon the amount of such proportion as aforesaid for the time being remaining unpaid, as the council may determine.

(5) Such interest shall be payable by such owners at the time or times, as the case may be, when payment of their respective proportions of the cost of construction, or of the several instalments thereof, is to be made.

(6) Any such owner may pay in advance the whole of his said proportion, or of any instalment thereof, with interest at the rate payable thereon to the date of such payment, and thereupon the interest payable by him shall abate accordingly.”

Application of Section 186 to certain streets.

3 The provisions inserted by Section Two hereof shall apply in respect of all private streets constructed prior to the commencement of this Act by the Council of the Municipality of Glenorchy, under or by virtue of the Glenorchy Private Streets Loans Act, 1928, and the moneys payable in respect thereof by every owner concerned shall be payable as provided by Subsection (3) of the said new Section One hundred and eighty-six without any request by such owner to the Council.

Repeal of Section 5 of 18 Geo. V. No. 28.

4 Section Five of the Town Boards Act, 1927, is hereby repealed.
