

AN ACT to further Amend "The Town A.D. 1901. Boards Act, 1896." [30. December, 1901.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

1 This Act may be cited as "The Town Boards Amendment Act, Short title. 1901, No. 2."

2 Section Seven of "The Town Boards Amendment Act, 1901," is 1 Ed. VII. No 16. hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof the following shall be and be 4d.]

deemed to be and may be cited as Section Seven of the said Act, that is to say :---

Chairman may be appointed Justice of the Peace.

"7 The Chairman of every Town Board may be appointed a Justice of the Peace in and for the District in which he resides, during his continuance in office as such Chairman. In this Section the word 'District' shall have the meaning assigned to it in The District Justices Acts."

Acts to be read together.

3 This Act and "The Town Boards Act, 1896," and every Act amending the same, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
