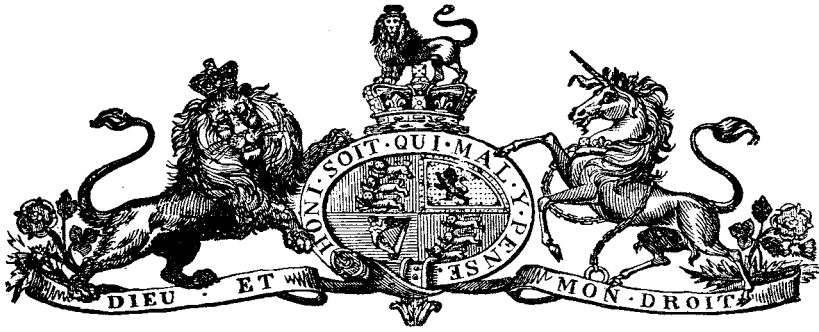

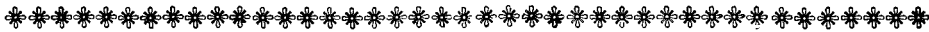

AN ACT to further amend *The Tasmanian Council of Education and Scholarship Act*. A.D. 1887.
[20 December, 1887.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in *The Tasmanian Council of Education and Scholarship Act* or any amendment thereof, the *Tasmanian* Council of Education may, with the consent of the Governor in Council, permit the holder of any *Tasmanian* Scholarship to hold such Scholarship at any University in the *Australian Colonies*. Scholarships may be tenable at Colonial Universities. 22 Vict. No. 21.

2 This Act, and *The Tasmanian Council of Education and Scholarship Act*, and every Act amending the same, shall, save so far as the same is amended by this Act, be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.
