

AN ACT to further amend The Tasmanian A.D. 1887. Council of Education and Scholarship Act. [20 December, 1887.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---
