## AN ACT to amend The Tasmanian Council of Education and Scholarship Act. [21 December, 1871.]

W HEREAS it is expedient to alter and amend The Tasmanian PREAMBLE. Council of Education and Scholarship Act: Be it therefore enacted by 22 Vict. No. 21. His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :-

- 1 The provisions of the said Act (save such of them as relate to the Act to apply to Tasmanian Scholarships) may be by Bye-law extended so that the youth of both same shall include and apply to the youth of both sexes.
- 2 It shall be lawful for the Tasmanian Council of Education from Council to fix time to time to appoint such days as it sees fit for holding all time for examinaexaminations under the provisions of the said Act; and in like manner to appoint the time from which each Tasmanian Scholarship shall commence. become tenable, anything in the said Act to the contrary notwithstanding.

- 3 This Act and the said Act, save so far as the same is affected or Acts to be read altered hereby, shall be read and construed together as one Act.
- 4 In referring to this Act it shall be sufficient to use the expression Short Title. "The Tasmanian Council of Education and Scholarship Act, No. 2."
