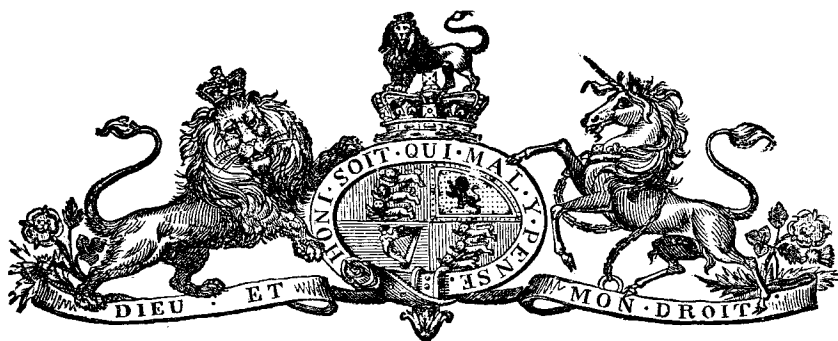

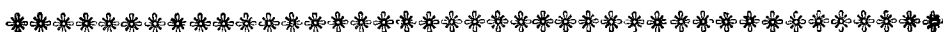

AN ACT to amend "The *Tasmanian* Council of Education and Scholarship Act." A.D. 1879.
[10 June, 1879.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to alter and amend "The *Tasmanian* Council of Education and Scholarship Act :"
PREAMBLE.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 It shall be lawful for the *Tasmanian* Council of Education, by any Rule or Bye-law made under "The *Tasmanian* Council of Education and Scholarship Act," from time to time to fix and appoint such day in each year as to the Council may seem desirable as the day upon which the ages of Candidates for the Degree of Associate of Arts or for the *Tasmanian* Scholarship, or either of them, shall in each year be ascertained and computed ; and thereupon the ages of the several Candidates, on the day so fixed in every such year, shall be deemed and taken to be the ages of the Candidates at the times of their respective examinations held during such year, anything in the said Act or any Act amending the same to the contrary notwithstanding. Council may make Bye-laws as to age of Candidates, &c.

2 This Act and "The *Tasmanian* Council of Education and Scholarship Act," and every Act amending the same, shall, save so far as the same is affected or altered hereby, be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.

3 In referring to this Act it shall be sufficient to use the expression "The *Tasmanian* Council of Education and Scholarship Act, No. 3." Short title.
