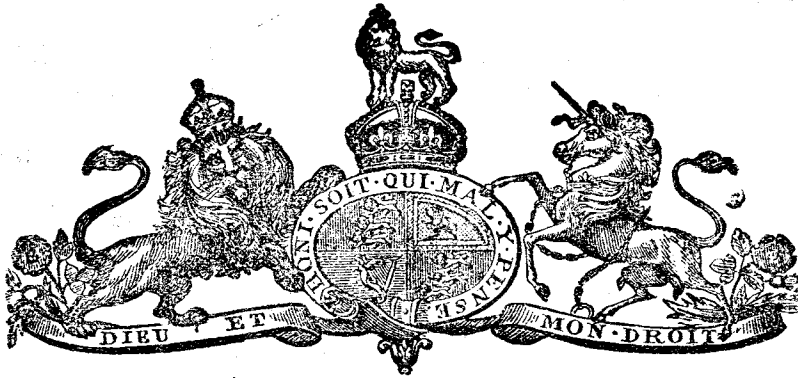

AN ACT to amend the Tasmanian Public
Library Act, 1902.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Tasmanian Public Library Act, Short title. 1930."

2 Section Eleven of the Tasmanian Public Library Act, 1902, is amended—

- i. By deleting the words "Thirty-first day of March" in the first and second lines, and substituting the words "Thirtieth day of September";
- ii. By inserting before the word "year" in the third and seventh lines the word "financial"; and
- iii. By inserting after the word "Library" in the fifth line the words "for such financial year".

Transitory
provisions.

3 The Trustees shall, on or before the thirtieth day of September, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one, make and present to Parliament the report mentioned in the said Section Eleven in respect of the period from the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and thirty, to the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one, and thereafter shall make such report in accordance with the said Section Eleven as amended by this Act.
