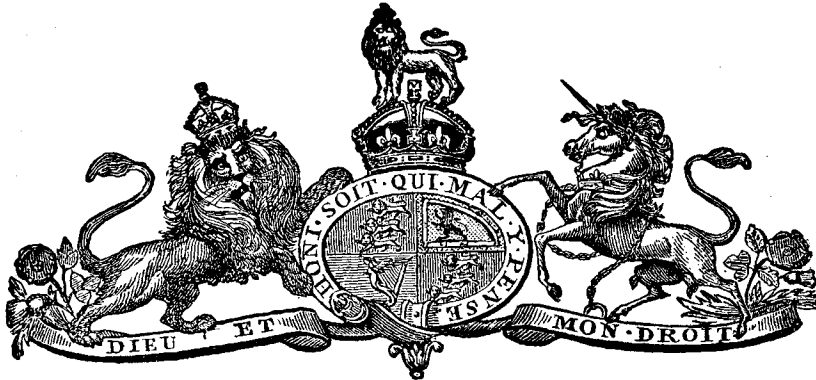

AN ACT to authorise and provide for the Payment out of the Consolidated Revenue of a Sum not exceeding Five thousand Pounds, subject to certain Conditions for the purposes of Unemployment Relief.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

Unemployment Conditional Relief.

Authority to

2—(1) Where the municipal council of any city or municipality, with a view to providing relief for persons out of employment, proposes to undertake or initiate any work or undertaking, it shall be lawful for the Treasurer, with the approval of the Governor, to pay to such council, subject to the provisions of this Act, a sum equal to the amount to be provided and expended by such council in and towards such work or undertaking.

(2) The aggregate amount of all payments to be made by the Treasurer under this Act shall not exceed Five thousand Pounds.

(3) The allocation of such sum of Five thousand Pounds among the several municipal councils who may make application to participate therein for the purposes aforesaid shall be determined by the Governor as he may think fit.

(4) The Treasurer, by notice in writing to every municipal council, may limit the time within which any such council may make application under this Act, and may specify the form in which such application shall be made and the particulars to be supplied therewith.

Appropriation of
£5000.

3 All moneys required for the purposes of this Act shall be paid out of the Consolidated Revenue, which to the necessary extent is hereby appropriated accordingly.
