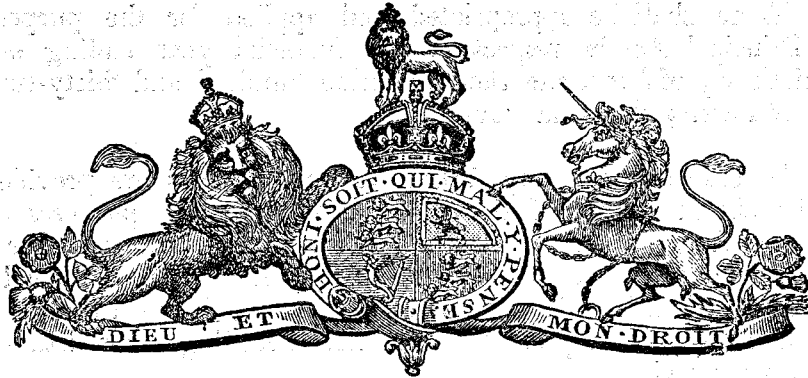

AN ACT to amend the Unemployment Relief Act, 1930. A.D. 1931.  
[3 August, 1931.] —

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1—**(1) This Act may be cited as “The Unemployment Relief Act, Short title. 1931.”

(2) The Unemployment Relief Act, 1930, is in this Act referred to 21 Geo. V, No. 3. as the Principal Act.

**2** There shall be appropriated and applied for the purposes of the Principal Act in respect of the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-two, the sum of Twenty thousand Pounds.

**3** Where by this or any future Act any moneys are provided by Parliament in respect of any financial year for the purposes of the Principal Act, the same shall be applied as if that financial year were substituted in Section Two of the Principal Act for the financial year therein mentioned, and the provisions of Section Three of the Principal Act shall apply in respect of a sum not exceeding one-fourth of the moneys so provided.
