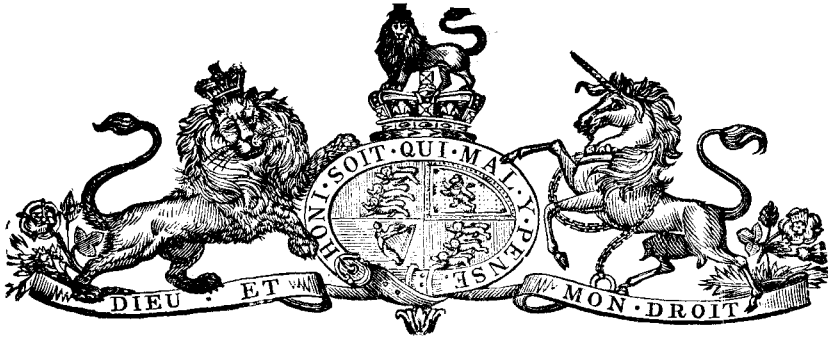

AN ACT to amend the Unemployment Relief Act, 1932. A.D. 1932.
[29 November, 1932.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Unemployment Relief Act (No. 2), 1932.” Short title.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting after Section Thirteen the following new Section **13a** :—

New Section 13a.

Moneys borrowed
for road works
may be repaid out
of road accounts.

“**13a**—(1) It shall be lawful for the Council of any municipality to apply the proceeds of any road rate levied and received by it upon and in respect of the property within any ward in or towards the repayment of any moneys borrowed by the Council under this Act and expended by it upon road works within that ward, or in or towards the payment of any interest payable in respect of such moneys.

“(2) The application of any moneys by a Council under this section shall be deemed to be expenditure as required by Subsection (3) of Section Thirty-six of the Local Government Amendment Act, 1911.”.
