

AN ACT to amend the Ulverstone Water Act, 1929.

[25 July, 1929.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as "The Ulverstone Water Act, Short title. 1929."
- (2) The Ulverstone Water Act, 1905, is herein called "the Prin-Principal Act. cipal Act." 5 Ed.VII. No.47.

Ulverstone Water.

Power to borrow.

2 It shall be lawful for the Council, on behalf of the Corporation, in addition to any moneys already borrowed under the Principal Act, to borrow under the provisions of the State Loans to Local Bodies Act, 1921, any sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole the sum of Seven thousand Pounds, for the purposes of carrying out the objects of the Principal Act.

Sinking fund.

3 The amount payable by the Council as an annual contribution towards a sinking fund in respect of any moneys borrowed under this Act shall be a sum equal to One Pound per centum of the moneys so borrowed.

Treasurer authorised to raise £7000

4 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to borrow, raise, and receive a total sum not exceeding Seven thousand Pounds for the purposes of this Act.
