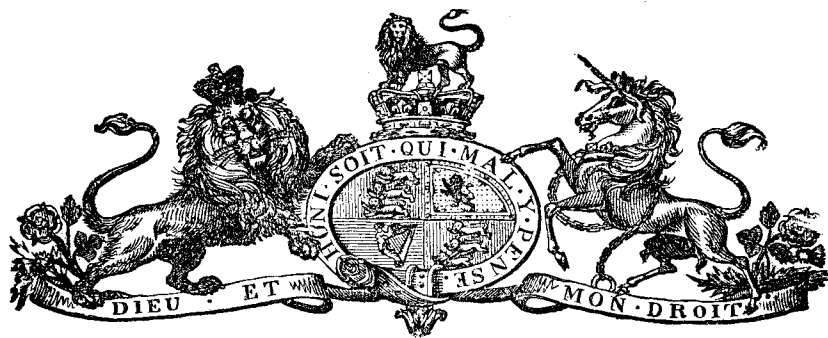

AN ACT to amend "The *Waratah and Zeehan* A.D. 1892.
Railway Act." [28 November, 1892.] —

WHEREAS it is desirable to extend certain provisions of "The *Waratah and Zeehan* PREAMBLE.
Railway Act" (hereinafter referred to as "the *Waratah and Zeehan* 55 Vict. No. 15.
said Act"): —

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The *Waratah and Zeehan* Short title.
Railway Act Amendment Act."

2 Where before the passing of this Act any enactment contained in Certain provisions
the said Act has expired such enactment is hereby revived; and of the said Act
whenever in the said Act any number or term of years or months are to revived and
be computed as from the passing of the said Act, such number or term extended.
of years or months shall hereafter be computed as from the Fifteenth
day of *September*, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-two.

3 This Act and the said Act shall be read and construed together as Acts to be read
one Act. together.
