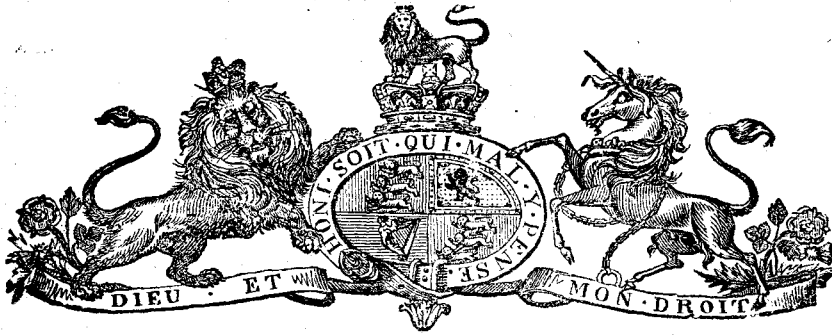

AN ACT to amend *The Waste Lands Act*.  
[21 December, 1871.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend *The Waste Lands Act*: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

PREAMBLE.

1 Notwithstanding anything contained in *The Waste Lands Act*, the Commissioner may cause a List of all such lands as are mentioned in Section Sixty-seven of the said Act, as may have been or may be exposed to rental by auction under the said Section and not disposed of, with the amount of rent fixed for the same respectively, or any reduced amount as the Commissioner may determine, to be published in the *Gazette*, with a Notice that any person who applies before a day to be named in such notice, (not being more than One year from the date of such auction), to rent any of such lands by private contract, may receive a Licence to occupy the same for pastoral purposes at the amount of rent named in such Notice: Provided, that if more than one application is received at the time named to rent the same lot, such lot shall not be let by private contract, but shall be again put up for rental by auction as soon thereafter as may be.

Lands not let by auction for pastoral purposes may be let by private contract

2 This Act and *The Waste Lands Act* shall be read and construed together as one Act.

Acts to be read together.

3 This Act may be cited as "The Waste Lands Act, 1871."
